

Menston Parish Councillor vacancy

There is a vacancy for a Parish Councillor to serve on Menston Parish Council.

The Parish Council determines the Annual Precept and is the publicly elected body that represents the village.

It supports local groups and projects like the Wharfedale Greenway, Menston Christmas Lights and the annual Armistice Day Service by way of grants. The Parish Council is a statutory consultee on planning applications and development issues in the village. The Parish Council has an appointee on the Kirklands (Menston) Trust and sends representatives to other partners and agencies as appropriate. The Parish Council works closely with the Menston Community Association.

This is a voluntary post and the successful candidate will be expected to attend the monthly Parish Council and Planning Committee meetings, usually held on the last Thursday of the month. Training is available.
